

EU & Irish Law - CSRD

The Corporate Sustainability Reporting Directive (CSRD) has become mandatory - this currently applies to large and listed organisations in the EU (250+ employees), but this scope will widen to include more medium and small businesses over the coming years.

Public Procurement & Tenders

The Green Public Procurement (GPP) strategy in Ireland and the (SPPP) policy in the UK require publicly funded bodies to include environmental and social criteria in public tenders. Non-compliance risks losing out on up to 10% of points in tenders in Ireland and 10+% in the UK.

B2B Procurement & Contract Negotiations

Large businesses, will need to report on the CSRD and are now including ESG requirements in policies and contract negotiations. So, even if you are not reporting directly now, your business will need to supply the required data to large organisations to stay in their supply chains.

Consumers are now aware of sustainability issues and are increasingly using sustainable businesses for their purchases. This shift in consumer behaviour signals the importance of embedding sustainability in business strategies so that you can tap into this growing market sentiment.
